HISTORY

Bart Kavanaugh and Betty Saks established their Donor Advised Fund at the Community Foundation of the Virgin Islands (CFVI) in 2003 with the purpose of strengthening the non-profit community in the territory and promoting philanthropy in the U.S. Virgin Islands.

With professional guidance from CFVI, the initiative was launched. This multi-phase project began with conducting a needs assessment. A survey was designed to gather basic contact information, leadership profiles, financial data, organizational structure, purpose, and developmental needs of non-profit organizations.

Agency leaders were then invited to attend focus groups to engage in a dialogue about both their organizational and professional needs. Non-profit agency leaders expressed a real need for a directory of non-profits to be made available to the profession for referrals and networking, and to the public to increase awareness of services available. This directory is a product of the initiative.

As a service to donors, CFVI is available to provide comprehensive organizational profiles of community non-profits to effectively guide philanthropic giving. CFVI is committed to connecting donors with identified community needs.
