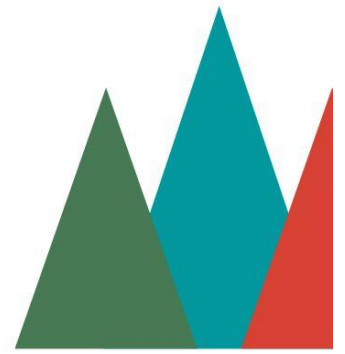

Grace Ministries - \$2,000 for children's gifts and care packages for the homeless.

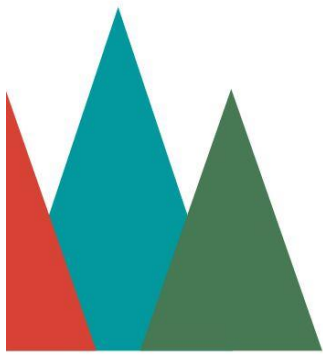

Leap and Learn Academy - \$5,000 to provide a holiday event with gifts and other activities for low-income families.

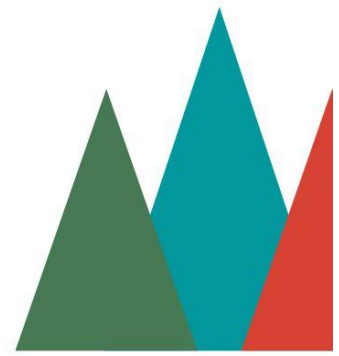
